

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY**  
**Final Environmental Impact Statement**  
**For Laurelwood Housing Area**

**Naval Weapons Station Earle, Colts Neck, NJ**

The Navy announces the availability of the Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) for providing access between the Laurelwood housing area at Naval Weapons Station (NWS) Earle, Colts Neck, NJ, and an adjacent state primary or secondary road. The FEIS has been developed in accordance with the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). The FEIS identifies the Navy's Preferred Alternative to provide access as Alternative 4. The FEIS will be available for review starting April 10, 2009 at the libraries indicated below or accessed at the following public website: <http://www.laurelwoodeis.com>.
